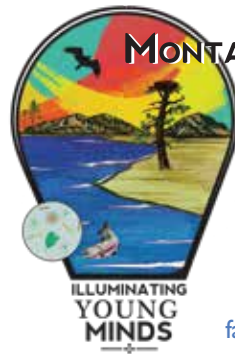

Discovery

Camp Discovery is a four-day, day camp for students entering **grades 1-3**. Campers are bused to MLC's campus on the shores of Canyon Ferry Lake from Helena Monday through Thursday.

Young Naturalist Adventures

Camp Young Naturalist Adventures is a five-day, overnight camp for students entering **grades 4-6**. Camp starts on Sunday afternoon and ends on Thursday afternoon.

Cost: \$500. Includes lodging, meals and snacks.

Innovations

Camp Innovations is a five-day, overnight camp for students entering **grades 7-9**. Camp starts on Sunday afternoon and ends on Thursday afternoon.

Cost: \$550. Includes lodging, meals and snacks.

Extreme Yellowstone Expedition

Camp Extreme Yellowstone Expedition is a six-day, overnight camp for students entering **grades 7-10**. Camp starts late morning on August 1st and ends the afternoon of August 6th. Paradise Valley serves as the hub for camping, meals and science experiences. It's also the perfect jumping off point for excursions to Geyser Basin, Yellowstone Falls and the Lamar Valley.

Cost: \$1,195. Includes transportation from MLC's campus to the Paradise Valley, camping, meals, snacks, high-ropes course and whitewater rafting.



Dinosaur Camp

MLC is partnering with Carter County Museum in Ekalaka, MT for a unique experience. Camp starts the morning of August 15th and ends the afternoon of August 20th. This adventure for students entering **grades 8-12** includes field expeditions to active paleontological dig sites. In addition to the activities at the fossil dig sites, campers will tour the museum, sort material collected in the field, learn the basics of fossil preparation and prepare fossils they gathered for display.

Cost: \$1,195. Includes transportation from MLC's campus to Ekalaka, camping, meals, snacks and all program-related fees.



Explore the Universe

Camp Explore the Universe is a five-day, overnight camp for students entering **grades 9-12**. Camp starts on the afternoon of July 11th and ends on the afternoon of July 15th. Using state-of-the-art telescopes to image the night sky, campers will gain astronomical knowledge and enhance their observing skills. During the day, campers will safely observe the Sun and engage in other STEM and recreational activities.

Cost: \$750. Includes lodging, meals and snacks.
